ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS in the face of crime or conflict, restorative justice offers a philosophy and approach that views these matters principally as harm done to people and relationships, and

WHEREAS restorative justice approaches strive to provide support and opportunities for the voluntary participation and communication between those affected by crime and conflict (victims, offenders, community) to encourage accountability, reparation and a movement towards understanding, feelings of satisfaction, healing and closure, and

WHEREAS the government recognizes the value that restorative justice provides our province in building safer communities, and

WHEREAS many communities in British Columbia have embraced restorative justice approaches to address the harm caused by crime, violence and victimization, and

WHEREAS this year's theme for Restorative Justice Week is "Inspiring Innovation", it is an opportunity to learn, educate and celebrate along with other communities across the country about restorative justice during the week;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 15 to 22, 2015, shall be known as

**"Restorative Justice Week"**

in the Province of British Columbia.
